

UPDATE PLEO™ SOFTWARE 1.1 (FROM AN SD CARD)

Updating your Pleo's software using an SD card is easy!

If your computer has an SD card reader/writer, you can download the latest version of the Pleo software from the Pleoworld Support page www.pleoworld.com/support/updates and copy the files to your own SD card to load into Pleo.

TO CREATE THE SD CARD:

1. Select the SD Card Installation icon on Pleoworld to download the new version .zip file to your computer.
2. Insert an SD card into the appropriate slot on your computer, and make sure the SD card is empty.
3. Open the .zip file and copy the new version files (including the sound folder) to the SD card.

TO INSTALL THE SOFTWARE FROM AN SD CARD:

Note: When Pleo's software is updated, he will be slow and groggy for a few minutes.

1. Make sure Pleo is turned off.
2. Insert a **fully-charged**, completely cooled battery into Pleo.

IMPORTANT: If the battery temperature is too high, a warning "honk" will sound. Remove the battery and allow to cool completely, then re-insert the battery and restart the update process.

3. Insert the SD Card containing the new version files into the slot on Pleo's belly.
4. Turn Pleo on.
5. You will hear several chimes followed by silence over the next few minutes as the software is updated.
6. When the update is complete, a final chime will sound. Pleo will awaken, call out, and then fall asleep. **Please do not remove the SD card before the update is complete.**
7. Turn Pleo off.
8. Remove the SD card.
9. Pleo is now ready to run with his new software.

WHAT'S NEW IN PLEO 1.1

- Pleo's attitude and emotions change based on how you interact with him. A happy Pleo is one who receives a lot of attention while a sad Pleo is one who is neglected or abused.
- Pleo may occasionally get sick - coughing and sneezing! Nurse him back to health by giving him lots of love and attention and feeding him his leaf.
- Pleo has learned a new trick - he knows how to sit! Try holding his chin and rear at the same time. He'll then pull his front and back feet together. Give him a nudge back by pushing down on his backside; don't forget to help him up when you want to keep playing.

- Petting Pleo on his chin for a long period of time will coax him to sing a variety of melodies, after which he will remember the song he stopped on and may use it for other things such as calling for attention.
- Pleo now recognizes his training leaf, and when he sees it he may open his mouth or call for it with a little panting sound.
- Pleo is tackling more difficult terrain such as high carpet by using a specially triggered “high-step” mode. To trigger this new walk, hold Pleo’s front legs and touch his Pleo button. He will remain using this walk until you reverse the command by touching the same sensors again or by powering Pleo off and then on again.
- Pleo has been picking up some strange habits as of late too - we’ve seen itchy feet and excessive chewing. **What’s your Pleo up to?**

When updated to 1.1, Pleo needs new versions of the Holiday and Love-struck downloads. You can get the 1.1 compatible downloads from the 1.1 update page.

If you’ve been using third party applications such as YAPT or MySkit, you will also need to use a 1.1 compatible version. Check with the individual third party sites for those updates.
